- To support economic diversification efforts and to make recommendations
- To represent the interests of our membership to all levels of governments through the development of official positions and/or policies

# **Committee Composition:**

• Minimum 1 Board Member + 8 or more members

## **Meetings:**

- November creates a policy survey to understand the policy needs of members
- December to review the GLCC policies falling off the BC Chamber and Canadian Chamber policy books
- January to review and create policies to put forward at the upcoming BC Chamber AGM and the Canadian Chamber AGM
- March to put forward those policies that have been approved by the Board
- Others as needed to address situations as they occur

### **Accountability:**

- The Committee has the power to advance advocacy issues and policy work that has been approved by the Board of Directors
- All new advocacy issues and policy work must be approved by the Board of Directors
